Andre E. Johnson, PhD, is a Professor of Rhetoric and Media Studies and the Director of Graduate Studies in the Department of Communication and Film at the University of Memphis. He is also one of the co-directors of the Colored Conventions Project. Dr. Johnson's research explores the intersection of rhetoric, race, and religion, and he teaches courses in political communication, rhetoric and public address, religious communication, interracial communication, prophetic rhetoric, and social movements. He is widely recognized as the leading scholar of the life and works of AME Bishop Henry McNeal Turner and has published two award-winning books, as well as numerous articles and book chapters, on Bishop Turner. He is currently working on a book about the 19th-century Colored Convention movement. In addition to his academic success, Dr. Johnson also serves as the Senior Pastor of Gifts of Life Ministries in Memphis, Tennessee.
